CONTROL POINT POSITIONING BY SATELLITE

This Table covers the establishment of control points for use as survey datum.

This type of work will always require three field parties. The survey fees for determination controls point coordinates with the use of satellite positioning systems shall consist of the following charges:

1)	Basic charge	RM 3,380.00
2)	Charge for mobilization and demobilization of the field parties:	RM
	a) Within 150 kilometres from nearest office	3,300.00
	b) Above 150 kilometres but not more than 300 kilometres	6,780.00
	c) Above 300 kilometres	10,170.00
3)	Charge for positioning of each point	5,460.00
4)	Charge for construction of monument in accordance to Lands and Surveys Department specification	1,040.00 per mark
4A)	The above charges are applicable when the survey worksite is within 1 kilometre from the nearest motorable road. For distances beyond the first kilometre, additional charges are to be applied as follows:	
	0 kilometre to 1 kilometre	No additional charge
	Above 1 kilometre but not more than 5 kilometres	Add 20% of 3 and 4 above
	Above 5 kilometres but not more than 10 kilometres	Add 40% of 3 and 4 above
	Above 10 kilometres	Add 70% of 3 and 4 above
4B)	In security areas –	
	a) Where a security pass or permit is required from the relevant authority, an additional charge of twenty five per centum (25%) of the survey fee is applicable; or	
	b) Where an armed escort is required and working hours are dictated by the relevant authority, an additional charge of fifty per centum (50%) of the survey fee is applicable; and	
	c) Where there is a waiting time after mobilization due to circumstances beyond the control of the Licensed Surveyor, an additional charge of RM 3,380.00 per day shall be applicable up to a maximum of 7 days.	
5)	Disbursements, where applicable, as provided in Table 14.
